POWER

IF YOU CRASH INTO A



STAY in your vehicle.

WARN bystanders to stay far away.



CALL 911 and wait for utility workers to arrive.



Assume all downed lines are energized and dangerous, even if they don't hum or spark.

Exit the vehicle **ONLY** if you notice smoke or fire:

1. Plan your exit route to avoid sagging or downed lines.

Jump clear of your vehicle.
DO NOT touch the vehicle and the ground at the same time.

3. Land with your feet together and shuffle away with small movements. Keep your feet close together and on the ground at all times.

5. Stay at least 100 feet away from the crash area until utility personnel tell you it's safe.
